Admissions Policy

Students are admitted to Chase Grammar School at any stage following the completion of assessments in English, Mathematics and attendance at a 'taster day' or interview. For international students the interview may be conducted by online. Students are expected to follow our guidelines of 'Expect to Achieve' and all school's rules, which are designed to create a healthy, safe and supportive community in which all students can thrive.

UK Boarders

Full UK Boarding Fees 2024-2025:

£25,751 per year

These fees include all of the following:

- Academic Tuition, School Clubs & Activities
- Textbooks, Stationery and all normal teaching materials
- Accommodation in Boarding House, Medical First Aid and Laundry
- Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner every day (Brunch and Dinner at weekends)
- Mid-term holiday residence and programme
- Arranging dental, optician and medical appointments

Additional fees include:

- Uniform (separate information will be sent once a place is accepted and deposit paid)
- Examination entry fees (for GCSEs, A Levels, IELTS, International Foundation Diploma and equivalents)
- Optional trips & expeditions (prices will be published when trips are advertised)
- Individual and small group Music, Dance and Drama lessons (see table below)
- Individual Learning Support lessons / Examination Scribe or Reader – £25 per hour pro rata

Fee Payments

The school fees can be paid annually or termly (before the start of each term). You may withdraw a student at any time provided that you give one full term's notice in writing before the first day of the final term. Otherwise a full term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged.

Refundable Deposit equal to one term's fees or £8,000 (whichever is the lower amount)

Arrival Times

Boarders should arrive at school between the hours of 08:00 – 21:00 on the published dates at the start of each term.

Vacations

Boarders may remain at school during the mid-term breaks, but must vacate the boarding houses for the duration of the Christmas, Easter and Summer vacations. The dates for residency are given below:

- Arrival day for Autumn Term: 04 September 2024
- Departure day before Christmas: 12 December 2024
- Arrival day for the Spring Term: 07 January 2025
- Departure day before Easter: 02 April 2025
- Arrival day for the Summer Term: 30 April 2025
- Departure day before the Summer: 10 July 2025





Scholarships & Bursaries

Scholarships

These are awarded to students who demonstrate exceptional levels of aptitude, motivation and potential in a particular discipline. The following scholarships may be awarded: Academic, Art, Dance, Drama, Music & Sport. Awards are made on the basis of assessments, interviews and references. They may carry a fee remission between 10%-50%. Scholarships are reviewed annually and require the scholar to make a significant contribution to the life and success of the school as well as individual progress. Sixth Form scholarships are available for 50% for students achieving three Grade 8/9's in their related subject choices.

Means Tested Bursaries

These are awarded to students who would benefit from the education provided by the school but whose parents are not able to afford the full fees. Parents are asked to complete confidential means-tested bursary forms, which are assessed using criteria supported by the Independent Schools' Bursars Association (ISBA). Awards are reviewed annually. Parental financial circumstances and the progress and motivation of the student are taken into account during a review. Evidence of ability to pay is required during the Bursary application process and the annual review.

Sibling Bursary

We welcome families to send all their children to the school and offer a 20% fee remission when children are in the school at the same time. Sibling discounts may be augmented by Means Tested Bursaries or Scholarships.

Staff Bursary

Children of members of staff may receive a remission of 50% (pro rata if the member of staff is part time).



Fee remissions are taken off core fees. These do not include:

- Uniforms
- Individual and small group Music, Dance and Drama lessons
- Individual Learning Support lessons / Examination Scribe or Reader
- School transport
- Optional trips
- Home stays
- Examination entry fees

Fee Payments

Fees may be paid annually (before the first day of the Autumn Term), termly (before the first day of each term) or in ten monthly instalments by by GoCardless or direct (these will be collected in the first week of the month, September to June). For monthly fee payer, the Autumn term fees will be collected over four monthly payments (Sep-Dec), Spring term three monthly payments (Jan-Mar) and the Summer term three monthly payments (Apr-Jun). Unpaid fees may accrue an interest rate of 2% per month from the date the fees were due until the date of payment. All values shown are in GBP and payments must be received in GBP when paid directly to the school.

Fees in Advance

It is possible to pay a lump sum of fees in advance for an agreed period at the current fee rate. For more details, please contact the Bursars Office on 01543 501817. All values shown are in GBP and payments must be received in GBP when paid directly to the school.



These fees include all of the following:

- Academic tuition, textbooks, stationery and all normal teaching materials
- Curriculum trips, House membership, Clubs and Activities
- Lunch

Additional costs include:

- A refundable deposit of £500 is payable to secure a place at the school
- Uniforms (separate information will be sent once a place is accepted and deposit paid)
- Examination entry fees (for GCSEs, A Levels, IELTS, International Foundation Diploma and equivalents)
- Optional trips & expeditions (prices will be published when trips are advertised)
- Individual and small group Music, Dance and Drama lessons (see table below)
- School Transport (see table below), provided by the school's own mini-buses and drivers
- Breakfast Club (07:30 – 08:30) – £5.50 per day
- After-school Club (16:45 – 17:30) – £5.50 per day

Notice periods

You may withdraw a student at any time provided that you give one full term's notice in writing before the first day of the final term. Otherwise a full term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged.

A half term's notice in writing is required if peripatetic lessons or school transport are to be discontinued, otherwise, half a term's fees will be payable in lieu of sufficient notice. No refunds are payable for lessons or transportation missed through a student's absence or tardiness. Every effort will be made to reschedule lessons clashing with school events.

Late Fees

If fees are paid late, they will attract interest at the rate of 2% per month.



Notice to Leave and Fees *In lieu of* Notice

Parents must give at least one full term's notice, in writing to the Principal, of their intention to take their son/daughter out of the school, before the first day of their final term. If such notice is not received, a further full term's fees will be due.

Additional Costs

Whilst our fees are essentially fully inclusive, there are some additional 'extras', for example exam fees, individual music lessons and transport. Extras will be invoiced termly.
